COMMERCIAL PLUMBING PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry (DLI)

DLI reviews plumbing projects of any system that serves the public, large numbers of people or affects the public health. Complete plans and specifications, together with any additional information that the Commissioner of the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry may require. Permit shall be submitted in duplicate and approved by the Commissioner, prior to a permit being issued by the City.

DLI reviews those proposed plumbing projects to ensure compliance with the Minnesota Plumbing Code (Minnesota Rules Chapter 4715).

General Commercial Permits

- Plans must be submitted to the State (*Contractor submits both site, building and plumbing plans to the State (DLI) and copies to the City. (Hospitals and schools are reviewed and inspected by DLI).*)
- The City must receive three (3) sets of plans and the state approval documents before any city inspections.
- Prior to issuing the Certificate of Occupancy for the building, the City must receive the final as built drawings or plans for plumbing utilities.

Public Building Permits

Public buildings such as hospitals and schools must submit plans to the State and will be inspected by the State. The City requires final as built drawings and plans for building/utility files.
